Nonprofit creates Board Intern, Board & Volunteer positions on their profile



YLC program participants sort through posted opportunities & click "Express Interest" in those they are interested in



Nonprofit reviews profiles of those who have expressed interest (candidates)



Nonprofit reaches out to schedule meetings with candidates they want to interview



Nonprofit identifies one or more interns or board members for posted role(s).



Nonprofit logs onto Board Connect to fill the position with the candidate's profile



Participant fills out paperwork automatically sent to them.



Match is complete and board can move forward with onboarding

- 1. April: Post Your Board Opportunity
- 2. April-July: Interview candidates and select one or more candidates you want to bring onto your board. Position should be filled on Board Connect Agreement signed. Please notify candidates not accepted for the opportunity
- 3. July or January: The Board Intern / Member begins their 12-month term

fall matching

Fall Program Participants will be introduced into Board Connect and actively looking for opportunities.

- 1. Oct: Post Your Board Opportunity
- 2. Oct-Jan: Interview candidates and select one or more candidates you want to bring onto your board. Position should filled on Board Connect and Agreement signed. Please notify candidates not accepted for the opportunity
- 3. July or January: The Board Intern / Member begins their 12-month term
